Through the free workshop visit, people could discover the processes of artisanal manufacturing; from the making of natural packaging to the production of natural soaps and cosmetics, including that of scented candles and incense cones. To end the stroll pleasantly, let's sample infused teas and speciality coffees in the on-site cafe. To go further on the experience, we offer workshop activities for those who want to experiment the handicraft by themselves.

WORKSHOP & GARDEN



1 - SPICES

Following the tradition, our spices are carefully selected in different Cambodian provinces. The spices are sorted, cut, cleaned, dried, grinded and mixed in our workshop.



2 - DELICATESSEN

Thanks to the richness of the local fauna and flora, there are many possibilities of flavors combination as flavoured sesame and coconut cookies or fruit jams. Free tasting.

3 - SOAPS

Our natural soaps, based on coconut oil, which is in abundance here, are handmade. Soaps in different shape are available in different scents, colored with natural and local ingredients.



4 - DISTILLATION

Senteurs d'Angkor creates its own essential oil in order to make the best product possible, from the raw material until the final product, the process are under control.



5 - INCENSE

The smoke of certain woods and plants have been recognized for raising serenity. Incense cones are made of kapok tree sawdust and leaves paste, mixed with water and perfume.



6 - CANDLES

Our aromatic candles are made of paraffin wax, beeswax, perfume and essential oils. The candle are also colored with natural ingredients as the lotus stamen for the yellow color.



9 - KREBEI RIEL

Those boxes are made from sugar palm tree branches. Our artisans come from Krebei Riel village, the only village that detains and masters this know-how, where Senteurs d'Angkor also provide sustainable work to 30 other women.



7 - COSMETICS LABORATORY

Concerning our own complete cosmetics range, we use the best natural ingredients such as coconut oil, jojoba oil and sweet almond oil blended with essential oils and beeswax. We only use natural preservative such as Vitamin E.



10 - PACKAGING

This workshop is the final step that highlights Senteurs d'Angkor's creations. More than 30 people are working here and take care of the bagging, bottling, labeling ... then packing in a smok or keibei riel box.

8 - WOVEN BOXES

The sugar palm tree is one of Cambodia's national icons. Here, we use these leaves to create boxes as a packaging for our products. Our artisans come from Kravann village where we provide sustainable work to 80 other women.



11 - BAR & SHOP

The visitors can enjoy a break with fresh drinks after the visit or taste the flavoured coffee. All the drinks we offer are made at Senteurs d'Angkor. The shop is the last step of the visit, where the visitors will find in the shop all the products made in the different workshops, but also products from artisanal cambodian brand, such as soap holders made from palm wood, ceramic oil burner ...

A Responsible travel is about rediscovering nature by immersing yourself in it, smelling it, feeling it and learning about it. Along the visit of the Workshop, You'll learn about the locals' relationships with their natural environment, how they co-exist together. Khmer people have been familiar with the nature, living harmoniously within it and get inspiration from it. Faithfully transposing this idea into a workshop area was the first aim of this project. The deeper you go into our visit, the more you'll understand part of the local culture.



GET CLOSER TO THE LOCALS

ARTISANS

Senteurs d'Angkor has given full value to the local handcraft. By offering meaningful souvenirs from Cambodia, we are committed to highlight the know-how of Khmer people. Along the visit, tourists will be introduced in the daily work of locals and could admire the creations of those people who have helped the project coming true. By supporting the traditional crafts, such as weaving of palm leaves or the cuisine and its spices, locals would pass the skills to the next generation and keep the art and craft alive.

WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

In the Khmer Culture, women are supposed to be more concerned with taking care of the home, of the children instead of growing personally and professionally, being independent. It is the reason why Senteurs d'Angkor has taken the side of women. Today, 83% of the employees of Senteurs d'Angkor are women coming from both the city and the countryside. By offering a training for beginners, a decent salary, good working conditions and financial help for study, Senteurs d'Angkor is committed in the women empowerment.

SUPPORT TO THE FARMERS

For the beginning, Senteurs d'Angkor has decided to collaborate with local partners to get hold of raw materials. All suppliers we work with have been selected in order to work with them sustainably. As far, we've maintained confident relationships with them in order to work together for the product quality. Visiting Senteurs d'Angkor is also supporting local NGO who are engaged in raising environmental awareness, local farms who are committed in organic agriculture and also independent farmers who want to lead the movement.

TROPICAL GARDEN


Senteurs d'Angkor takes place in one of the unique tropical garden in Siem Reap that honours the diversity of the Cambodian nature. Out of the city, you'll immerse yourself in a sensorial experience thanks to the different smells and tastes you'll find on your path. In order to maintain natural green spaces, this typical local ecosystem has been thought to make the walk enjoyable. This project is part of environment preservation by using green energies as solar pump or solar panels.

RICHNESS OF CAMBODIAN FLORA

Cambodia is one of the most biodiverse countries in Southeast Asia, with as many as 8,260 plant species. In order to highlight this richness, Senteurs d'Angkor daily works on the raw material in a sustainable way. Nowadays, we handle 36 different kind of fruits and plants to create our souvenirs range. On this way, it ensures a variety of smells and products for all tastes. We purchase the coffee beans from the Mondulhiri province located in the East of Cambodia, the sugar palm and pepper come from the South. Each part of Cambodia has its own treasure.

POWER OF NATURE

The safest way to taking care of ourselves skin is trust the Nature ! As we know, natural products contain lots of hydrating properties, which helps with a whole heap of problems. Plants and their variety of biochemical resources act on our nervous system and fruits are packed with vitamins which is the perfect combination. Vitamin E in particular is known to promote a healthy scalp and shiny hair. That's the reason why all the ingredients we use are natural and carefully selected for their benefits. All products are paraben-free, silicone-free, sulfate-free and not tested on animals.



MEANINGFUL SOUVENIRS
